### SITUATION AT OUTSET



**ULTIMATE GOAL:**  
Reducing the scope of intimate partner violence

**MISSION:**  
We wish to create a multi-sector partnership capable of systematic, long-term actions to promote awareness of the various forms of intimate partner violence and prevent them in the Israeli society

**VISION**  
To bring about change in Israeli society, lead to a **significant reduction in intimate partner violence**, in-depth **awareness**, sweeping condemnations of violence, creation of a **supportive communal, social, and public framework** to prevent violence from spreading and provide engaged and appropriate help in leaving violent relationships. This is in addition to professional, accessible, and high-quality programs tailored to a range of needs adapted to individual, gender-based and cultural characteristics, all intended to **stop violence and prevent it from developing**

### Systemic barriers to effective prevention and early detection of IPV

- » Lack of statistics on phenomenon and scope
- » Lack of public and philanthropic resources for prevention
- » Preventive efforts aimed mostly at victimized women and not at men
- » Lack of wide and systematic educational efforts
- » Lack of broadly accepted terminology for describing the phenomenon
- » Lack of public awareness of the phenomenon and of available responses
